EXPERIENCE IN ORTHOPAEDIC SURGERY

I had my training in Orthopaedic Surgery since 1989 at the National Orthopaedic Hospital, Igbobi, Lagos – Nigeria.

This is a specialist centre of Excellence in Orthopaedic and Traumatology in West Africa. It is also a W.H.O. collaborating centre. It undertakes several thousands of surgical operations yearly, and also an educating centre for Orthopaedics with workshops, seminars and courses yearly. It also runs an Orthotic and Prosthetic Training Centre.

I have spent six years as a trainee, progressing from S.H.O. to Senior Registrar. My Surgical Training also included secondments to other surgical departments in Lagos, Nigeria at the Lagos University Teaching Hospital. As a Senior Registrar, I was actively involved in the supervision of Junior Residents and tutorials and lectures for visiting medical students and Post Basic Nurses in training at N.O.H.L.

As a consultants orthopaedic and trauma surgeon, I have been treating my own patients in the last 6 years. I run two clinics during the week – a fracture clinic and an orthopaedic clinic. I also run a specialized clinic which takes care of patients with back pain. I do all types of General orthopaedic surgical procedures including hip and knee replacement. I also manage post-traumatic patients; especially those who require limb fixation with different types of devices and implants.

As a lecturer; I teach medical students and I train resident doctors in different surgical specialties; including orthopaedics and trauma. I am also involved in the training of Nursing students and post basic Nurses.

SURGICAL SKILLS ACQUIRED

I have been trained in and can perform the following operations, plate and screw fixation, arthroplasty, femoral and tibia nailing, Arthrodesis of the knee, ankle and foot joints Corrective osteotomies, circlage wire fixation of patella, olecranon, medial malleolus, K-wire fixations, application of external fixators. Athrotomy of joints, manipulation and reduction of fractures and dislocations. My training also include the management of Trauma patients.Soft tissue release for C.T.E.V., tendon transfer to correct unbalanced paralysis especially in post-polio paresis and cerebral palsy.

I have assisted in several operations including total hip and knee replacement, laminectomy, (cervical and lumbar) Harrington's rod spinal fusion for scoliosis on a few occasions.

EXPERIENCE IN OTHER SURGICAL SPECIALTIES

The National orthopaedic hospital is a centre for the training of orthopaedic and traumatology. However to qualify for the part I examination of the Colleges (WACS, and NMCS), the resident has to have some training in other Surgical areas. I had my rotations stated before in General surgery, Urology, Neuro-Surgery Plastic/reconstructive Surgery and paediatric Surgery at the Lagos University Teaching Hospital (LUTH).

SURGICAL SKILLS AQUIRED

The experience gained include the ability to perform surgeries presenting in the above areas, including trauma. The following operations were performed: Appendectomies, Explorative laparotomies for various indications, including emergencies. Splenorrhaphy, Splenectomy, Bowel resection and anastomosis, drainage and feeding procedures (Gastrostomy and jejunostomy). Others include colostomies, Herniorraphies (umbilical, inguinal etc).

The skill for the care of patients with intra-abdominal abscesses and other infections was also acquired.

Urological procedures done include supra-pubic cystostomies for bladder outlet obstructions, urethral strictures, and post traumatic urethral injuries. Glandulo-cavernous shunts for priapism. Others include Herniotomies and orchidopexy for children; surgery for testicular torsion and post traumatic drainage of scrotal haematomas, including penile traumas and circumcisions.

I also acquired some experience in Neuro-Surgery and did some craniotomies, craniectomy for various indications unsupervised.
